SNOW REMOVAL UPDATES FOR 2025-2026 SEASON

WHILE SNOW IS THE LAST THING ON OUR MINDS IN AUGUST, WE WANTED TO SHARE A FEW IMPORTANT UPDATES TO SHOREWOOD'S SNOW REMOVAL CONTRACT AS WE PREPARE FOR THE UPCOMING WINTER SEASON. THESE UPDATES ARE AIMED AT IMPROVING ROAD SAFETY THROUGHOUT SHOREWOOD AND WE WANT TO THANK THOSE WHO SHARED THEIR FEEDBACK DURING/AFTER THE 2024/2025 WINTER SEASON.

WHAT'S NEW?

- OUR VENDOR WILL NOW PLOW AUTOMATICALLY FOR SNOWFALLS OVER 2 INCHES (PREVIOUSLY 3 INCHES)
- FOR SNOWFALLS UNDER 2 INCHES, THE VENDOR WILL WAIT FOR OUR APPROVAL BEFORE PLOWING.
- SALTING HAS BEEN EXPANDED: THE VENDOR WILL NOW SALT ALL MAIN ROADS AND INTERSECTIONS DURING PLOW EVENTS (PREVIOUSLY ONLY SALTED INTERSECTIONS).
- CUL-DE-SACS ARE EXCLUDED FROM ROUTINE SALTING.

WHEN TO CONTACT 3-1-1

AS YOUR HOA BOARD, WE RECEIVE A WIDE RANGE OF QUESTIONS FROM NEIGHBORS—AND WHILE WE'RE HAPPY TO HELP WHERE WE CAN, THERE ARE MANY ISSUES THAT FALL OUTSIDE OF THE HOA'S RESPONSIBILITIES. FOR THOSE, THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE'S 3-1-1 SERVICE IS AN INCREDIBLY HELPFUL RESOURCE. HERE ARE SOME OF THE MOST COMMON REASONS RESIDENTS IN OUR COMMUNITY REACH OUT:

DRAINAGE ISSUES

IF YOU'RE EXPERIENCING POOLING WATER IN YOUR YARD OR HAVE CONCERNS ABOUT STORMWATER DRAINAGE, 3-1-1 CAN CONNECT YOU WITH THE CITY'S STORMWATER DEPARTMENT. THEY CAN INVESTIGATE TO SEE IF THE ISSUE INVOLVES PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE OR IF IT'S SOMETHING THAT NEEDS TO BE HANDLED PRIVATELY.

CITY CODE VIOLATIONS & PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

SEE A LAWN THAT HAS GRASS OVER 9 INCHES TALL, A VEHICLE PARKED ON THE STREET THAT HAS NOT MOVED IN OVER 24 HOURS, OR OTHER CITY CODE CONCERNS? THE HOA HAS NO ENFORCEMENT POWER OVER CITY CODE ISSUES, BUT 3-1-1 CAN TAKE A REPORT AND SEND A CITY INSPECTOR IF NECESSARY.

NOISE OR NEIGHBOR DISPUTES

WHETHER IT'S LOUD MUSIC LATE AT NIGHT, BARKING DOGS, OR SOMETHING THAT'S CREATING TENSION BETWEEN NEIGHBORS, 3-1-1 CAN GUIDE YOU ON WHETHER IT'S A NOISE ORDINANCE VIOLATION OR ANOTHER ISSUE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OR MEDIATION SERVICES.

TRASH, RECYCLING, AND BULK ITEM PICKUP

NEED TO REPORT A MISSED TRASH PICKUP? WANT TO REQUEST A REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT GARBAGE/RECYCLING CART? NEED A BULK ITEM PICKED UP? 3-1-1 CAN HELP!

STREETLIGHTS, POTHOLES, OR TRAFFIC CONCERNS

IF THERE'S A STREETLIGHT OUT, A POTHOLE ON A CITY STREET, OR A TRAFFIC CONCERN LIKE SPEEDING IN CERTAIN AREAS, SUBMIT A REQUEST THROUGH 3-1-1 AND IT WILL BE ROUTED TO THE APPROPRIATE DEPARTMENT.
